1. Joint School Student Revival Camp

On 13th April, the CCC Principals' Associations jointly organized the CCC Model Students Prize Presentation Ceremony to recognize students' efforts in their excellence in academic and non-academic development. Our students 3C Chen Zhi Hui and 6C Wong Tsan Mei were nominated for the award.

4. Student Forum

On 22nd April, the Student Association organized a student forum for schoolmates. Top Management, some middle managers and I were invited to attend the forum to listen to students' voices. The participants were representatives elected by their classmates to express their opinions on the execution of the School Rules and Regulations and the qualities of school premises. Both students and teachers had good opportunities to share their views on the topic. We gained much understanding of each other and some measures will be followed up.

Mathematics Department

- (3) On 24th April, the Mathematics Department co-organized with the School Library to organize a book-sharing session. Twenty-eight students joined the activity.
- (4) Our students 1A Lui Ching Yu, 1A Wong Man Long, 1B Lee Cheuk Yin and 2C Lau Pui Tung participated in the Hong Kong Secondary Mathematics Creative Problem-Solving Competition 2024 organized by the Education Bureau. Ms. Chu KM was responsible for the training.
- (5) The Mathematics Society organized an activity 'Monthly Mathematics Challenge' to arouse students' interest in Mathematics. The winners for November were 1A Zhou Ziyue Bill and 2D Law Hau Kei.
