1. School Information Day

Our school has held the event for sixteen years. Mathematics Department

- (1) On 5th December, the Mathematics Society organized a Rubik's Cube Competition, including teaching and competition parts.
- (2) On 9th December, the Department organized a Pre-Mock Examination of Mathematics in Paper II (Multiple Choice) for S.6 students so as to provide them with more opportunities to become familiar with various question types.
- (3) On 9th December, our school organized the Wong Tai Sin Joint Primary School

Mathematics Competition. About one hundred students from fifteen primary schools participated in the competition. The competition aimed to test participants' reasoning power, problem-solving abilities and collaboration skills.

- (4) On 18th December, our students were awarded in the first-round competition of the Pan-Asia Pacific International Mathematics Competition: First Runner-up (1A Yang Hiu Ching, Lui Ching Yu and 1D Chung Chi Man), and Second Runner-up (1A Wong Man Long, Wang TangWade, 1C Li Ching Tak, Kwan Hoi Fung, 1D Chan Ho Ching and 2B Chan Ho Yin) and Merit (1A Cheung Ho Yeung).

Physical Education Department

- (1) On 8th December, our school Boys' Grade A table tennis team won the 1st runner-up in the Inter-School Table Tennis Competition.
- (2) On 16th December, our school Girls' volleyball team won the 3rd runner-up of the BOCHK Beach Volleyball Cup 2023-2024.
- (3) On 17th December, our school Girls' Grade A volleyball team won the 3rd runner-up of the Inter-School Volleyball Competition.
- (4) On 17th December, 3C Jiang Yuk Chun and 2A Chow Tin Nok won the champion titles in the Boys' U16 and Boys' U14 high jump respectively in the Hong Kong Junior Age Group Athletics championships (Round 4).

19. Report from Moral and Civic Education Committee

- (1) Responsible for the content of the morning assembly in December, holding a flag-raising ceremony and "Speech under the Flag" every Tuesday. The topics in December are: "2023 National Constitution Day Online Quiz Competition" 5/12, "Memorial Day for the Victims of the Nanjing Massacre" 12/12, and "Christmas and Chinese Traditional Culture" 19/12.
- (2) National Security Education: On 5th December, a National Constitution Day Online Quiz was organized. Students used iPads to complete the competition in the morning assembly
- (3) The Chinese-style marching and flag-raising team was organized by inviting instructors from the Hong Kong Police Force to teach students skills for the flag-raising ceremony and Chinese-style marching. Twelve students attended classes every Saturday morning in December.
- (4) The seventh "Citizen Ambassador" training program: We nominated 5D Lee Yiu Sing and Lee Ming Yi to participate in this program. On 9th December, the two students took part in the interview. If selected, students will participate in the Civic Education Resource Center as docents and other civic and national education promotion activities voluntarily.

20. Report from Academic Affairs Committee

- (1) The "Organising Workshop" conducted by the Academic Prefect Team was successfully held from 4:00 to 5:00 after school on 1st December. A total of 3 Form One students participated. This workshop aimed to help Form One student properly

organize their learning materials and make their work more organized. The main content of this workshop was for the Academic Prefects to share their time management experience and help participating students organize their school bags and lockers. Mr So WL and Mr Tang SF were the teachers in charge of this activity.

- (2) The "Past Paper Workshop" organized by the Academic Prefect Team was successfully held from 4:00 to 5:00 p.m. after school on 15th December. A total of 26 Form One students participated. This workshop was designed to help Form One student become familiar with the format of the school's examination papers and for their seniors to share their revision skills. The main content of the workshop is for Academic Prefects to share their revision experience in various subjects and to try out past papers with their classmates. Mr So WL and Mr Tang SF were the teachers in charge of this activity.
- (3) On 1st December, as part of our Learning Support series, our committee invited elite alumni who achieved excellent results to conduct a sharing session with our Form 5 students. The alumni shared their experiences on how to manage their schedule and study techniques so as to effectively prepare for the DSE examinations. Ms Lau SH was the teacher in charge of this session.
- (4) On 8th December, a talk to Form 3 students was conducted by Ms Cheung PY during form assembly to briefly introduce the Senior Secondary curriculum. The purpose was to prepare the students to make preliminary choices on their senior secondary elective subjects. From 13th November to 28th November, we collected opinions on the current senior secondary subject combination from teachers through Google Forms. From 28th November to 12th December, teachers had a chance to express their opinions by approaching Ms Cheung PY or Mr Tai TTT from the Data Analysis Team. The data collected would be used for the evaluation of the subject combination and to set the electives subject in different elective levels. The aim is to provide a combination choice that suits the choices of the majority.

21. Report from Extra-Curricular Activities Committee

- (1) The Singing Contest was held by the Students' Association on December 20. Participants and the student audience both enjoyed participating and watching the contest.
- (2) All the 9 interest classes for the first term were finished. The classes for the second term will be started in February.

- (3) The rope skipping team took part in the 1st New Territories Regional Rope Skipping Open Championships and won the 2nd runner-up in the 2x30-second Speed Relay and 30-second 4-person Long Rope. They won the overall 2nd runner-up Team Award for Boys aged 13 to 15.

- (2) From 12 to 19 December, S.6 students opened the application account of the EAPP system in the CEP lesson.
