7. Report from Subject Departments

English Department (English KLA)

- (1) Four students and Class 5C have achieved remarkable success in the 75th Hong Kong Schools Speech Festival. Details are as follows:

- (2) 6 students participated in the Canadian English Writing Competition 2024 (Arch Cup): Live Preliminary Competition held by The English Association of Asia, on December 2, 2023 (Saturday). The results are as follows:
Chau Ching Yu 6B (2): Gold award;
Ng Sze Wing Elizabeth 3A (18): Silver award;
Ng Hoi Lam 1A (18), Ng Man Yan 1D (22), Wong Kei Tung 5B (26), Wong Tin Wan 5D (29): bronze award
They have been invited to participate in the live semi-final competition, which will take place on 3rd February (Saturday).
- (3) A seminar for parents of S.1 students titled "How to Practically and Effectively Support Your Children's English Learning in Secondary School" was successfully held on 20th January (Saturday). The event saw a turnout of over 80 participants, representing more than 50 families. During the seminar, Ms. Chan Ka Yan and four S.2 students shared common difficulties faced by students in learning English and practical ways to enhance language learning. The parents also had the opportunity to engage in discussions and share their own experiences.
- (4) The briefing session for the UK Study Tour 2023-24 was successfully held on Saturday, with an impressive turnout of over 400 participants from more than 200 families. Mr. Tang Siu Fung, Eric, along with A Team Travel Limited, provided a comprehensive overview of the tour and explained the application procedure to the attendees. We are pleased to announce that we have received over 70 applications so far. To proceed further, students will be scheduled for interviews on 4th and 5th February, where they will have the opportunity to showcase their suitability for the tour.
- (5) On 19th January 2024 (Friday), a total of 27 students from S.6A – S.6E, led by Mr. Ho Ka Chun and Ms. Yau Yee Yeung, participated in a Joint-school Oral Practice organized by Buddhist Hung Sean Chau Memorial College. Students expressed positive feedback on the invaluable experience gained and the comments given by teachers and peers.
- (6) Professional Development Activity/Activities :

- On 18th January, Ms. Chan Ka Yan, Mr. Tang Siu Fung, Eric and Mr. Tse Ho Fung, accompanied by Principal Chu, attended a professional sharing session with Ying Wa College. The session revolved around an intensive discussion on strategies to enhance students' English proficiency.
- On 13th and 24th January, Ms. Chan Ka Yan participated in a seminar and an online workshop respectively, which focused on the utilization of Artificial Intelligence to support students' writing organized by the International New Standard Education (INSE) and International Education Technology Federation (IETF).
