6. Report from Subject Departments

English Department

- (1) Four S.5 students, namely Chan Tak Ming (4) from 5A, Kuge Kentaku (9) from 5A, Cheng Wing Yan (7) from 5D, and Lee Yiu Sing (19) from 5D, participated in the PolyU Invitational English Speech Contest held on 14th October, 2023 (Saturday). While they were unable to advance to the final round due to intense competition, all of them have gained confidence in public speaking and developed their communication skills and critical thinking through their participation in three workshops provided by PolyU and the contest with over sixty contestants. Additionally, their effort in preparing and delivering a speech to an audience of over a hundred people in a lecture theater is highly appreciated.
- (2) Six students, namely Chau Ching Yu (2) from 6B, Wong Kei Tung (26) from 5B, Wong Tin Wan (29) from 5D, Ng Sze Wing Elizabeth (18) from 3A, Ng Hoi Lam (18) from 1A and Ng Man Yan (22) from 1D, have successfully advanced through the Elimination Competition of the Canadian English Writing Competition 2024 (Arch Cup) held by The English Association of Asia. They have been invited to participate in the live preliminary competition, which will take place on December 2, 2023 (Saturday).
- (3) A group of seventeen students from S.1 to S.3, accompanied by Ms. Chan Ka Yan, Mr. Tang Siu Fung, Eric, and Mr. Tse Ho Fung, had a wonderful time at Shouson Theatre, Hong Kong Arts Centre, watching the English drama 'A Midsummer Night's Dream' and gaining an appreciation for the effort required to produce a full-fledged performance during a backstage tour on 7th October, 2023 (Saturday) from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. Following the tour, a series of drama workshops, jointly organized by LCSD and Shakespeare4all, spanning a year, commenced on 19th October, 2023.

Mathematics Department

- (1) On 9th, 16th, and 23rd October for S.1 participants and on 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th & 31st October for S.2 – S.3 participants, Mathematics Olympic Training Classes for junior form students started in October. Ms. Yu Pik Ching and Mr. Tai Tze Tik were the coordinators.
- (2) From October onwards, the Mathematics Society is conducting the 'Monthly Mathematics Challenge' to arouse students' interest in Mathematics. The winners for October were Lee Yiu Sing (5D) and Chan Yiu Hin (3A).
- (3) Our students participated in the Thailand International Mathematics Olympiad 2023-2024 (Hong Kong Selection Competition).

- (4) On 30th October, the Mathematics Department organized a Mathematics Talk “Big Data in our Life” to introduce the use of Big Data in our daily life. We invited Dr. Ng Tsz Tim of the Mathematics and Finance Department of the Hong Kong Hang Seng University as the speaker. Eighty students attended the talk.
- (5) On 3rd, 16th and 26th October, the Mathematics Department organized a workshop for drilling Multiple Choice Questions for S.6 students. Mr. Wong CT, the Vice-Principal, Ms. Mr. Tai TT, Mr. Lee SF and Mr. Li WK were responsible for the workshop.
- (6) The Mathematics Department recruited Ho Sum Ying (4E), Leung Hui Yin (4B), Wong Chun Fai (3B), Wong Sze Wan (4C) and Wong Hoi Ching (4B) to be the Mathematics Reading Ambassadors to promote reading in Mathematics. They shared a topic ‘Healthy Life Style’ during the Morning Assembly. Mr. Li WK and Mr. Tsui HM were responsible for the scheme.
- (7) The Mathematics Department published a magazine *Mathgazine* and distributed it to students to introduce Mathematicians’ stories, HKDSE past paper questions revision and a concept about ‘Infinity’.
- (8) Others
The Mathematics Department jointly organized the territory-wide Mathematics Competition for Primary School Students with the Department of Applied Mathematics of Hong Kong Polytechnic University. On 6th October, the competition started to open registration for the competition and the deadline will be 31st October.

Chemistry Department (Science KLA)

- (1) A team of six S3 students participated in the “International Junior Science Olympiad” Competition organized by the Hong Kong Education Bureau. They earned three Third Class Honour.
- (2) One team of three S.3 and two S.4 Chemistry students was nominated to join the “Hong Kong Budding Scientists Award” organized by the Education Bureau.
- (3) Thirty-eight S.4 to S.6 Chemistry students participated in the “2023 International Chemistry Quiz (H.K. Section)” organized by the Royal Australian Chemical Institute. Our students earned seven High Distinctions, twelve Distinctions and fourteen Credits out of seven thousand Hong Kong Students.
- (4) Thirty-five S.6 Chemistry students were nominated to join the “HKDSE Chemistry Mock Examination” organized by the Hong Kong Jing Kung Press Limited.
- (5) One team of four S4 Science students was nominated to join the “Energy Innovation” Competition organized by the Hong Kong Institution of Engineers and the Hong Kong China Light and Power.
- (6) Three S5 Chemistry students were accepted to join the “Junior Science Institute” organized by the University of Hong Kong.
- (7) Twelve S6 Biology and Chemistry students were nominated to join the “International Pathology Day Workshop 2023” organized by the Hong Kong College of Pathologists.
- (8) One S5 Chemistry student got the Champion of the “Occupational Safety and Health

Council 35th Anniversary Stamps Design Competition” organized by the Hong Kong Occupational Safety and Health Council.

- (9) On 14th October, one S3 student participated in the “Science in the Public Service - Upgrading and Transformation of Online Statistical Products” seminar organized by the Hong Kong Science Museum.
- (10) Professional Development Activity/Activities :

Geography Department

- (3) On 19th October, two Geography Society activities – The Geography online quiz and Chocolate lava cake workshop – were held.

Physical Education Department

- (1) On 1st October, 2A CHOW TIN NOK jumped his personal best of 1.68 m in the Boys U14 High Jump in the WAC Annual Challenge 2023 and got the Championship.
- (2) On 2nd October, 3C JIANG YUK CHUN jumped his personal best of 1.92m in the Boys U16 High Jump in the WAC Annual Challenge 2023. This performance not only made him the champion of the competition, but also met the training standards of the Hong Kong Athletics Association for the Hong Kong team, allowing him to become a potential athlete at the Hong Kong Sports Institute.
- (3) On 5th October, Our athletics team also won the first runner-up for both boys and girls 4x100m relay in the 45th Inter-school Relay Invitational of Ng Wah Catholic Secondary School. The team members were: 4E Wong Tak Chi Dennis, 3C Jiang Yuk Chun, 4B Chan Wai Sing, 3D Fung Ping Kei, 3B Wong Ching Chi Doris, 4B Chan Tsz Yau, 4B Chan Ka Lam, 4C Lau Suet Yan.
- (4) On 15th October, 3C Jiang Yuk Chun got the Championship in the Men’s U16 High Jump in the Hong Kong Junior Age Group Athletics Championships 2023.
- (5) On 21st October, 3C Jiang Yuk Chun got the Championship in the Boys’ C Grade High Jump in the TCAA Athletics Championships 2023 - Round 3.

- (5) On 24th October, an art workshop, Perler Beads was held. The workshop created interesting bead artworks. The participants had fun while having completed their bead artwork.

7. Report from the Academic Affairs Committee

- (1) The School Policy concerning the Senior Secondary curriculum was introduced to F.4 students. Videos about the Add-Drop Policy, SBA Policy and Mark for Determining OMF and Pass Mark were uploaded to F.4 form-based Google Classroom. Another video introducing the SBA declaration form was also uploaded for students’ reference.
- (2) On 13th October, the First Term Life-wide Learning Day was held successfully. All S.1 to S.6 participated in different activities outside school.
- (3) A Learning Skills Training workshop (Note Processing and Learning Style) by Edvenue was carried out on 17th and 24th October in F.1 Chinese History lessons. For F.4, an active Revision Skills Training Programme (with memory) was launched during Class Assembly as an introduction. A workshop was carried out between 12th to 25th October in F.4 Mathematics lessons for students to apply the skills.
- (4) To promote reading, the Mathematics and Life & Society departments were invited to share in the morning assembly on 4th and 25th October respectively to arouse students’ interest in readings of different subjects.
